Posterior Tibial Tendon Problems The posterior tibial muscle originates at the back and inside of the main bone of the leg (the tibia). The muscle becomes a tendon just above the ankle, which then runs from behind the inner knob of the ankle (the medial malleolus) to below this knob.

The posterior tibial tendon runs behind the inside bump on the ankle (the medial malleolus), across the instep, and into the bottom of the foot. The tendon is important in supporting the arch of the foot and helps turn the foot inward during walking.
