Sickle cell anemia (sickle cell disease) is a disorder of the blood caused by an inherited abnormal hemoglobin (the oxygen-carrying protein within the red blood cells). The abnormal hemoglobin causes distorted (sickled appearing under a microscope) red blood cells. The sickled red blood cells are fragile and prone to rupture. When the number of red blood cells decreases from rupture

The factor that symptoms reoccur is that the red blood cells can act generally for much of the time but if something makes too many of them sickle, the sickle cells cause symptoms. If there are severe and sudden symptoms due to sickling, this is called a sickle cell crisis.

Other serious symptoms of sickle cell disease include blood clots and strokes, eye problems (retinopathy, retinal detachment, bleeding in the eye), kidney damage, prolonged penis erections (priapism), spleen damage, anemia (symptoms of anemia are shortness of breath, lightheadedness, and fatigue), heart attacks, and liver problems.

A doctor may suspect sickle cell anemia based on symptoms an on routine blood test results. Early diagnosis of sickle cell anemia in children is extremely important. A simple, inexpensive blood test called hemoglobin electrophoresis is used to confirm the diagnosis, and can be used on newborn infants to screen for the condition.
